## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The water trials will be held in accordance with the provisions of the PWDCA Water Trial Manual. Participants are responsible for familiarizing themselves with the regulations. The manual may be downloaded from the PWDCA website ([www.pwdca.org](http://www.pwdca.org)).

## ELIGIBILITY

Minimum age of handlers is 9 years old. Participants under 18 years of age must have a parent or legal guardian present at the trial site while they participate. Minimum age of dogs is six months old. Dogs six months old but under one year old must earn a Junior Certificate before entering at the Apprentice level.

A dog may only be entered and exhibited once at any test level on each day. A dog must have an Apprentice Water Dog (AWD) title to enter the Working Water Dog (WWD) level, a WWD title to enter the Courier Water Dog (CWD) level, and a Courier Water Dog Excellent (CWDX) title to enter the Master Water Dog level. A Junior Water Dog Certificate is NOT required to enter the AWD level (provided dog is over one year of age).

***An owner or handler must notify the Trial Secretary if a dog earns a water title or certificate after the dog has been entered in this water trial.***

## ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRIES – FEES, OPENING DATE, CLOSING DATE, ENTRY LIMITS

### Entries Open: 8:00am EDT Monday May 15, 2023

- All entries MUST be made online through PerfDog.com
- A dog may compete only once per trial day.
- Entry fee is \$43 per entry and includes a \$3 PerfDog Processing Fee to be paid by the competitor
- Online entries will not be accepted unless they are properly completed, and the appropriate fee has been paid.
- Properly completed entries will be accepted in the order received.

**Entries Close: 6:00pm EDT Wednesday June 21, 2023.** ACCEPTABLE ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE CLOSING DATE, after this time, entries may not be accepted or substituted.

Properly completed entries will be accepted in the order received up to 35 entries or 8 hours of judging time per judge per day, whichever is greater. The host club has the right to refuse any entry for any cause they deem to be sufficient.

## NON-REGULAR ENTRIES

As per the PWDCA Water Trial Manual, a dog may enter as a non-regular entry at the same level he or she has previously earned a title.

Exhibition Only entries will be accepted if the trial does not fill with regular entries. A dog may not be entered as both a regular and exhibition only in the same trial. Post entries, including day of trial move-ups by teams who have qualified at their regular test levels, will be accepted up to the previously stated judging limits.

Non-Regular entries, including Exhibition Only, will be waitlisted until after the closing date. If space is/or becomes available, these entries will be moved off the waitlist at that time.

## WAITING LIST

After 35 entries or 8 hours of judging per judge per day is reached, a wait list will be created by 'first received'. Entries will be moved off the wait list, in the order they were received, if space becomes available. If a space is available, the Trial Secretary will notify the competitor by email of the available space. The competitor has 48 hours to accept and pay for the space to be accepted into the Trial. If the space is not accepted and paid within 48 hours of the notice, the space will no longer be available to the competitor and the space will be offered to the next competitor.

## REFUNDS

**Prior to close of entry:** Entries and activities may be cancelled or changed online prior to close of entry, with refunds (less the PerfDog Processing Fees) available to keep as PerfDog credit or refund to credit card.

**After close of entry:** Entries and activities may be cancelled after close of entry, with a refund available (less the PerfDog Processing Fees) provided the space can be filled by a team on the waiting list.

Entry and activity fees shall not be refunded if the dog is absent, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Please contact the Trial Secretary if you would like to cancel so your space can be voided and may be offered to someone on the waiting list. Contact the Trial Secretary with any other changes to your entry after the closing date.

## MOVE-UPS (CHANGE OF ENTRY LEVEL)

A regular entry may be moved to a higher test level before either trial if the dog is eligible for the higher level. The Trial Secretary must be notified in writing by filling out a move-up form (available at the Trial Secretary's table) at least one-half hour before judging begins.

## TRIAL SITE RULES AND CONDITIONS

Dogs must be kept on leash or confined in crates at all times, except when participating in a warm-up session in the test area or while being judged. The test area will be clearly marked, as well as crating, spectator, parking, and practice areas. The practice area will not be available during the trial. Only dogs actively being judged are allowed in the test area. Please ensure crates are in the shade with adequate ventilation and water. Participants are responsible for picking up after their dogs.

## TRIAL & EQUIPMENT CHECK-IN

Exhibitors may use their own equipment if approved, after inspection by the Host club or judge's designee. Equipment will also be available by the Host club. Please get your equipment checked in as soon as possible. You cannot check in with the Trial Secretary for your armband until your equipment has been approved.

**Check-In begins Friday 12:00pm – 3:30pm and will continue Saturday & Sunday 7:30am – 10:00am.**

## LIFE VESTS & FOOTWEAR

Any person in the test site must wear a USCG approved life vest and closed-toed protective footwear.

## SUBSTITUTE STEWARDS

A handler may use his or her own substitute steward. The substitute steward must be named on and sign the entry form. Substitute stewards must be familiar with the Water Trial Manual and must conduct themselves according to the applicable provisions of the Manual. Request for a change of steward must be made before the start of judging of that level and must be approved by the Trial Secretary and the Judge. Complete the Substitute Steward section of the [Volunteer Form](#). Note: if the Substitute Steward is not an entrant, then the Substitute Steward must accept the Participation Agreement in the Documents section of PerfDog.

## PRACTICE DAY

The trial site will be available for practice on **Friday, July 14<sup>th</sup> from 8:30am – 3:30pm** for teams entered in the trial. Practice will end promptly at **3:30pm** to allow club members to set up the trial site.

- **Sign-up: You must be present to sign up** for a timeslot (10 min timeslot per dog)
- Only one practice slot is allowed per dog entered in the trial
- Bitches in season will be allowed to practice, but only at the end of the day. Please let the Trial Secretary know as soon as possible to make accommodations.
- **Cost is \$12/dog payable through PerfDog and includes a \$2 PerfDog Processing Fee**

## VOLUNTEERS

Our trials cannot be successful without volunteers. All experience levels are welcome and needed. If you are capable of volunteering, or would like to learn, complete the sign-up form: [Volunteer Form](#). All volunteers must complete a Participation Agreement. If a volunteer is not competing, a Participation Agreement can be completed via the Extras section in PerfDog at no cost. Contact for more information regarding volunteering.

## ORDER OF JUDGING AND JUDGING PROGRAM

To balance entries as evenly as possible over the two trial sites, the Host Committee will determine judging assignments after entries have closed. A judging program containing the days' event schedules and the order of judging of teams will be emailed to each exhibitor with the final entry confirmation. The test level order of

judging will be Saturday Deck Side Trial Site: Master, Apprentice, and Junior. Playground Trial Site: Working and Courier. Sunday the test level order will be reversed. The following are time estimates for each level:

Junior (10 min)      Apprentice/Working (15 min)      Courier/Master (20 min)

The presentation of the colors and the National Anthem will proceed the judges briefing at 7:50am Saturday. Judges' briefings will begin at 8:00am on Saturday & Sunday. Lunch, and other breaks, will be at the discretion of the judges.

## **BITCHES IN SEASON**

Bitches in season will be judged after all other canines have been judged for the Trial (this means both sites if there are more than one trial site). The owner or handler of any such bitch must notify the Trial Secretary of the bitch's condition before the start of the day's judging. Handlers may not bring bitches in season to the test area or the surrounding area until they are instructed to do so by the Judge or the judge's designee. During the Friday practice day, please notify the Practice Coordinator before bringing your bitch into the practice area. The same procedure will be followed for the practice day as for the trials.

## **INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY**

If there is lightning and/or thunder during the trial, teams will be required to leave the water. This will be at the sole discretion of the judge. Resumption of the trial is also at the sole discretion of the judge, but no sooner than 30 minutes after the last thunder. Testing will resume where it left off and continue as scheduled. Depending on the total time of the delay, the Trial Chairperson and Trial Secretary will determine if there is sufficient time to complete the trial in the allotted time or whether a "one and done" policy will be adopted.

## **DOG AGGRESSION POLICIES & LAW**

Movers & Shakers will follow the guidelines set forth in Chapter 5 of the current PWDCA Water Trial Manual and North Carolina state law.

## SENIOR CHALLENGE

The Senior Challenge will take place on **Saturday** immediately following the completion of the trial. This non-regular water event is being offered to celebrate our Senior Dogs. This event offers the senior dog an opportunity to participate with their handler in a water activity and continue their engagement in the sport.

**If your dog is not physically sound enough to safely participate, please do not enter this event.**

Senior Challenge Details:

- Senior Challenge Judge: Jill Flebotte
- Open to dogs who turn 10 years old in 2023 or older
- Only dogs deemed physically sound will be allowed to participate
- Life jackets for dogs are permitted
- Required to successfully complete three water exercises of the handler's choosing
  - Choose 3 levels (1 exercise): Apprentice, Working, Courier and Masters
- Regulation equipment is required
- **Important Entry Processing Information:** The Entry Fee is *payable* through PerfDog. However, the Entry Form should be completed through the link below.
- **Entry Fee is \$22 payable through PerfDog and includes a \$2 PerfDog Processing Fee**

Dogs who successfully complete the challenge will be awarded a special activities rosette during the Saturday evening Awards Dinner.

## QUACK 'N FETCH

The ever-popular Quack 'n Fetch will take place on **Saturday**. Buy a chance on a rubber duckie. Ducks will be offered through lunch on Saturday, or until all ducks have been claimed. This event is not limited to owner/handlers of entered dogs, nor is it limited to one duck per person. The more ducks you buy, the better your chances you win.

### What is the Quack 'n Fetch?

Immediately after a trial site has finished, all ducks that have been purchased will be released into the Lake. Three PWDs will be selected in advance to swim from shore to fetch a duck. The first dog and duck back to shore will be award 3<sup>rd</sup> place, the second dog back will be awarded 2<sup>nd</sup> place, and the third dog back will be awarded 1<sup>st</sup> place.

Proceeds from the ducks will be split in the following manner:

- Movers & Shakers – 50%,
- First Place (last dog back) – 25%
- Second Place (second dog back) – 15%
- Third Place (first dog back) – 10%

**Cost:** Each Duck is a \$5 donation and is available for purchase at the Trial before this activity. Ducks will be available for purchase as a 4 pack through PerfDog for \$22 and includes a \$2 PerfDog Processing Fee.
